



Code of Conduct

Indian Lake Nazarene Camp (ILNC) is a covenant community under the Church of the Nazarene, existing as a sacred place to experience spiritual renewal, relationships, and recreation. Everyone who lives permanently or seasonally at ILNC shall seek to keep Christ at the center.

The ILNC Board, under the Michigan District of the Church of the Nazarene and in compliance with the "Covenant of Christian Conduct" in the *Manual* of the Church of the Nazarene, adopts the following principles and behaviors for our permanent and seasonal residents:

- Love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength (Matt. 22:37). Be courteous and helpful to everyone (Eph. 4:32). Convey a Christian character in your language and actions, as described in Gal. 5:22-3, which includes showing a spirit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
- Support both physically and financially the ministry of ILNC, and participate in public worship as possible while here at ILNC as well as at your local church (Heb. 10:25)
- Dress always with modesty and abstain from sexual immorality (1 Cor. 6:18), as defined in Section 31: "Human Sexuality and Marriage" of the *Manual* of the Church of the Nazarene.
- As a Christian camp and community, music, literature, and entertainment need to reflect our beliefs (1 Cor. 10:31)
- The use of alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs, or the misuse of prescribed medications, is prohibited on ILNC grounds. (1 Cor. 5:11)

Living at ILNC, be it seasonal or long term, is a privilege. It also requires a willingness and determination to honor the above principles and behaviors.

Failure to adhere to these principles and behaviors, as determined by the Camp Board of Directors, the Executive Director, or the Superintendent of the Michigan District Church of the Nazarene, in their discretion, can be grounds for disciplinary action up to and including termination of seasonal or full-time residency privileges.

Signing this Code of Conduct is an affirmation that you will live by the principles and behaviors stated above. It also indicates that you have read and agree with each statement and Scripture reference.
